#### User Guide & Maintenance Recommendations

Use a good felt brush or a soft cloth to pick up as much residue as possible left by the markers. It should be changed several times a year to avoid spreading the ink accumulated on the brush. For best results, do not hesitate to clean your board with a soft cloth and soapy water. A little liquid really helps to remove the residues better.

#### **Additional Details**

You are writing on a "Design Plus" type film which allows you to personalize your board by adding lines, your logo or colors. You are **not** writing on a porcelain surface with a 50 year guarantee, so it is normal to proceed with a different and more frequent maintenance.

#### Recommended Maintenance Frequency

Once a day or more according to use. The longer the writings stay on the board, the harder it is to remove it.

### **Recommended Cleaning Brush**

Soft and clean cloth or a felt brush.

#### **Recommended Markers**

Markers from the brands Pilot, Pentel or Staedtler are excellent options. For easier writing without residue, we recommend using alcohol-based markers. Low-odor markers (water-based) give inferior results because the ink can leave residue while drying, making the board harder to clean.
